18 Kolinbrunnen (Kolin Fountain) Historic fountain dating from 1541 featuring a statue of an unknown person.

19 Lohri House The world's oldest goldsmith's house. Gold has been smelted here since 1620.

22 Konditorei & Kaffeehaus Treichler

Synonymous with Zug's coffee culture, this is the perfect place to try a Kirschtorte, right on the Bundesplatz.

23 Confiserie & Café Strickler Serving Zuger Kirschtorte and other cherry treats in Zug and Menzingen.

24 Etter Distillery World-famous Zuger

Kirsch and the finest fruit brandies. Four generations of family tradition since 1870.

25 Heiner's Destillate The finest Zuger Kirsch and other spirits.

- 3 Zugerberg (Zug Mountain) A favourite destination for outings, this mountain is perfect for hikers, mountain bikers and families with children.
- Holzhäusern Golf Park Beautiful golf course with a superb restaurant surrounded by greenery.
- 5 Cherry Blossom Hike Spring hike from Zug to Goldau during the cherry blossom season.
- 6 Wildspitz Zug's highest peak offering unrivalled panoramic views.
- Villettepark Idyllic and spacious park with majestic ancient trees right by Lake Zug.

Morgarten Monument Memorial to the Battle of Morgarten, where the Swiss Confederation faced its first test in 1315. Ziegelei Museum

(Brickwork Museum) Modern museum dedicated to building with bricks. Also has an outdoor adventure playground.

Zuger Depot Technikgeschichte (Zug Depot of Technical History) Features original restored vehicles and objects from the technical and military history of the Canton of Zug.

Ägeribad pool and spa Modern spa and swimming pool right by Lake Aegeri.
